Regular Board Meeting

Superintendent Darrell Johnson gave information about the Opening of School program and the Student Engagement Conference. “Both were a great success”.

Superintendent Darrell Johnson talked about the Absolute Rating by the SC Board of Education.

RTI Coordinator Jean Powell gave an overview of the processes and strategies used to create professional learning communities and response to intervention.

Instructional Specialist Amy Hildenbrand gave a summary report of the summer learning program held at Woodfields Elementary School. This program was funded through a grant received from the 21st Century Learning Initiative.

Magnet School Program Coordinator Cathy Chalmers gave a description of the ACTS (Arts, Communication, and Theatre School) Magnet Program, the STEMS (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) Magnet Program.

Director of Elementary Education Pearly Milton gave information on the Montessori Program and the Single Gender program.
