Regular Board Meeting

Superintendent Darrell Johnson stated that Mid-Year Graduation will be held Thursday, January 20th at the Greenwood High School auditorium.

Dr. Johnson announced that the State of the District Address will be held Friday, February 11th at the Greenwood Country Club beginning at noon.
