Regular Board Meeting
December 13, 2010

State Senator Floyd Nicholson presented Emerald High School teacher Stacy White the Order of the Silver Crescent on behalf of the Governor. Stacy's mother, Peggy Beckham, accepted the award in her daughter's absence.

Superintendent Dr. Darrell Johnson announced that mid-year graduation will be held on January 13, 2011 at Greenwood High School auditorium beginning at 5 p.m.

Dr. Johnson acknowledged Greenwood County Adult Education staff for their recent success at the annual Adult Education State Conference held in Columbia. The Adult Education program was recognized for the number of Work Keys certificates awarded in 2009-2010. Adult Education teachers Martha Henderson and Ella Sanders were inducted into the Adult Education Teacher Hall of Fame at the conference.

Board Chairwoman Debrah Miller provided details about a Food Bank Challenge being held in January for the local soup kitchen. Greenwood County and the City of Greenwood have challenged the district to provide as many canned food items as possible for the needy.
