

## Board Briefs

September 20, 2010

### Regular Board Meeting

Superintendent Darrell Johnson recognized Hodges Elementary School as a Title I Distinguished School Finalist in the Closing the Achievement Gap category.

Superintendent Johnson gave information regarding the formation of a Secondary Schedule Review committee to study schedule options for next year.

Superintendent Johnson announced the State Superintendent of Education Candidates Debate will be held on September 22<sup>nd</sup> at Lander University Cultural Center beginning at 5:30 p.m.

Instructional Technology Specialist Cindy Hughes gave a summary of Oncourse, a web based teacher planner information system that organizes plans for instructional supervision.

Assistant Superintendent Randy Vaughn presented the most recent enrollment numbers for the district.

Response to Intervention Coordinator Jean Powell gave an overview of the district's RTI program.

Assistant Superintendent Gary Johnson presented information pertinent to the FY10 budget. No recent state budget cuts this fiscal year were reported. There is an estimated 4 million dollar shortfall in next year's budget.

Southern Management representative Forest King presented the monthly update of the district's building program.
