

Board Briefs
Regular Board Meeting
February 20, 2012

In the Superintendent's Report, District Teacher of the Year Debbie Leonard presented information on the Teacher Forum spring project entitled "Changing Children One School at a Time." Carrie Gable of Merrywood Elementary, Kayla Zinck of Northside Middle School, and Samantha Quattlebaum of Emerald High School were presented certificates for winning the campaign logo design contest.

Board Chairman Shell Dula along with Dr. Darrell Johnson recognized Debrah Miller for her 15 years of service to the Board of Trustees.

Dr. Johnson gave an overview of OurEducationVision.com, a new website created by the South Carolina superintendents to provide direction for public education in our state.

Assistant Superintendent Patricia Ross provided a summary of the Elementary and Secondary Education ACT (ESEA) flexibility waiver request. The State Department of Education will submit a proposal to the U.S. Department of Education requesting the waiver on February 28th.

Assistant Superintendent Gary Johnson presented information pertinent to the FY12 budget and the monthly update of the district building program.

In action items, the Board approved the 2012 Bond Resolution.

The Board approved the low bid of \$1,078,132 from C.E. Bourne Roofing of Greenwood for the replacement of the existing roof system at the G. Frank Russell Career Center.
